

Quest Summer Camp and Year-Round Program

Dear Families and Guardians:

Thank you for your interest in registering your child(ren) for our Quest Program and summer camp at Sherwood Forest! Please review the enclosed information with your child. In this packet, you will find information about the summer program in which your child will be participating as well as information on how to register.

Important Information for You and Your Child

At Sherwood Forest, we love and appreciate that all of our campers hike to the beat of their own camp song! However, EVERY camper must meet the following criteria to be successful at camp:

- 1. They must want to come to camp.
- 2. They must have a willingness and ability to learn and participate in a group.
- 3. They must be able to care for themself independently.
- 4. They must listen and follow the directions given to them by the staff at camp.

These are required and not negotiable to ensure camp is safe, kind, and fun for all.

There are a few things you and your child should know before applying to this program:

- 1) This is a commitment. Our goal is for campers to remain in our program until they graduate from the Leadership Training Program and hopefully, through the Supports for Success program, which works with them though high school and post-secondary education or training.
- 2) If you and your child choose to apply for this program, they are committing to attending the entire summer camp session and participating in year-round programs. Arriving late or leaving early is not an option, so please consider your family's holiday plans, your child's summertime and extracurricular activity schedule carefully.

<u>Returning Campers</u> – Registration opens in <u>September</u>. Your camper's spot for summer 2025 will be held until <u>November 1st</u>. You have until this time to register your child(ren) for camp either online or through the mail. After <u>November 1st</u> enrollment in camp will be open for new campers and we cannot guarantee a spot for your child. If you are having difficulty completing the initial paperwork, please contact our office at 314-644-3322.

<u>New Campers</u> – Registration opens on **Friday**, **November 1**st. New campers will automatically be placed on the waitlist while their application is reviewed and a space in confirmed. Once a new camper's registration has been confirmed, you will receive information about upcoming year-round programing. We expect all new campers to participate in year-round programming prior to camp.

PLEASE NOTE that 80% of our spaces are reserved for campers who qualify for the Summer Food Service Program and that we accept new campers who are completing 1st through 6th grade. Our 7th, 8th, and 9th grade programs are only open to returning campers.

New Camper Meet and Greet:

To prepare your child for camp, we require all new campers to participate in an in-person meet and greet with our staff. During this session, your camper will engage in group activities and games, allowing us to observe how they interact in a group setting. We will also speak with each camper individually to discuss their upcoming camp experience and address any questions they may have. We kindly ask parents and guardians to step away during this time so that the camper can speak freely.

New Family Orientation:

To help new families prepare for camp, we also encourage all new families to participate in an online orientation with our staff. Orientation is designed to help you and your camper learn more about camp before the summer begins. We will review the basics of camp life, our camper conduct policy, show pictures of camp, and answer questions from campers and their families. Orientation dates will be provided once we have received your completed application materials.
